SEMI- ANNUAL FALL CLEAN UP SCHEDULED

Fall/Winter 2011

Fall Clean-up is scheduled for **Saturday, October 1, 2011 from 8:00 AM to 12 noon.** Once again, as an added convenience to residents, the Township will also receive bulk items on **Friday, September 30, 2011 from 6:00 AM to approximately 1:45 PM.**

This event is provided "**ONLY**" for residents as part of their trash collection service. This privilege is not transferable to anyone outside of the Township. The stub from your last trash bill is necessary as proof of residency.

A resident is permitted to bring **ONE** eight (8) foot pick-up truck- sized load, (NOT a loaded pick-up with a trailer behind it) to the rear of the Township building on New Valley

Road for unloading into dumpsters. Four (4) car or passenger truck tires per residence are also permitted. **No tractor or equipment tires.** Refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners must have the Freon removed.

NO hazardous materials are permitted such as: treated lumber, turpentine, paint thinners, paint strippers & removers, varnishes, paints, drain cleaners, pool chemicals, weed killers, pesticides, fuel additives, brake fluid, gasoline, kerosene, anti-freeze & batteries.

These items will **NOT** be accepted!

Please separate larger bulk items such as washers, dryers, water heaters, etc, & place them so they are easily accessible to facilitate unloading of these items to a separate dumpster for scrap iron. *Thank You!*

SINGLE STREAM (Co-Mingled) RECYCLING COMES TO RYE TOWNSHIP

Beginning October 3, 2011

Recyclables you bring to the Township can now be Co-Mingled. **THAT MEANS “EXCEPT FOR CARDBOARD”, WHICH MUST BE FLATTENED & PLACED IN A SEPARATE DUMPSTER, ALL OTHER RECYCABLES NO LONGER NEED TO BE PRE-SORTED AND MAY BE MIXED TOGETHER.**

The items accepted without pre-sorting at the drop off recycling bins are as follows:

- **Aluminum Cans**—crushed if possible.
- **Bi-metal Cans**—Steel food and beverage cans and Aerosol cans
- ➡ • **Clear, Green, and Brown Glass Containers**
YES!!! We once again accept glass bottles and containers!
- **Plastic Jugs, Jars & Bottles with necks smaller than their bases**
(All plastics—#1- #7)
Rinsed, no caps or lids, and crushed if possible
- **Newspapers & Inserts** (*Larger amounts tied and not wet*)
- **Empty Paper Towel & Toilet Paper rolls**
- **Envelopes , Junk Mail AND Office paper** (*Larger amounts tied and not wet*)
- **Magazines**
- **Phone Books & other soft Cover Books**
- **CARDBOARD**—**MUST** be broken down & flattened to fit into a separate roll off container

- **NEEDLES** • **TUPPERWARE CONTAINERS** • **PLASTIC GROCERY BAGS**
- **WINDOW GLASS /MIRRORS** • **PLASTIC TABLEWARE - Knives, Forks, Spoons**
- **OIL & CHEMICAL CONTAINERS** • **LIGHT BULBS** • **STYROFOAM, BUBBLE WRAP**

**EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT
HOLDS DISCUSSIONS**

First a tornado in May, then an earthquake, and now a flood. The weather in 2011 certainly has been unpredictable. These weather events have prompted the Board of Supervisors and Emergency Management Coordinator Jim Cassidy to hold several roundtable discussions along with Marysville Fire Chief, Scott Weaver, to evaluate and to seek to improve coordination and communication during emergency operations. After dealing with the extended power outages recently, the Board is considering the purchase of two generators— one for the Township building and one for the Glenvale Church of God also located on New Valley Road, which is the designated disaster evacuation center for Rye Township.

Communication during an emergency is key. During the May tornado many were without power for several days and their portable phones were dead and cell phones could not be charged. The following two simple reminders for RESIDENTS are very important during a time of emergency:

1. Keep a land line phone.
2. Purchase a car charger for your cell phone.

Rye Township Emergency Management needs your help to identify Township residents, who may require special assistance in an emergency. Emergencies can cause great hardship, especially for the elderly and those with disabilities. It may be difficult or impossible for some residents to evacuate their homes in an emergency. The Rye Township Emergency Plan provides emergency personnel with a confidential listing of persons with special physical and/or medical concerns to alert them of the special need (s) in the event of an emergency. We maintain & update this listing routinely to better serve you. Should you or a member of your family like to be included in this listing, please contact the Rye Township office at 957-2348. Participation is strictly voluntary. *Thank You!*

ALSO, the Board of Supervisors' Office maintains an Email Notification Listing, which is used to notify residents of any public notices. The recent Boil Water Advisory Notice was emailed to all those on the notification list.
