

## Spring Clean-up Scheduled May 6th & May 7th



Even though Penn Waste is contracted to collect the weekly trash, the Township will continue to hold two semi-annual bulk clean-ups. The first event is scheduled rain or shine on **Friday, May 6 from 6:00 AM to 2:00 PM & Saturday, May 7, 2011 from 8:00 AM to 12 noon** in the rear lot at the Township building. **This service is ONLY provided to residents.** Each residence is permitted to bring one pick-up truck-sized load. Four (4) passenger or small truck tires per household are permitted. Hazardous materials are **not** permitted such as paint products, turpentine or paint thinners; automotive products such as brake

fluid, antifreeze, oil; gasoline; garden pesticides. **NO BATTERIES.** **NO** asbestos shingles, treated lumber, pool or lawn chemicals. All larger Refrigerators and/or Freezers must have the Freon removed and also the doors.

For your convenience, dumpsters will be available on Friday for residents unable to attend on Saturday, May 7th.

We ask that you separate larger bulk items such as washers, dryers, water heaters, refrigerators, etc, and place them so they are easily accessible to facilitate unloading of these items to a separate dumpster for scrap metal.

**Please bring the stub from your last trash bill as proof of residency. ♦**

## DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION REQUIRING PUMPING STATISTICS

First we want to express appreciation to residents that responded to a previous request to provide septic tank pumping receipts for your on-lot septic system. Second, as of March 2011 only approximately 27% of all systems are documenting compliance. The Department of Environmental Protection & Rye Township are looking for a much higher percentage of residents to assure proper maintenance and less introduction of high

levels of nitrogen, phosphorous & organic materials into the environment. As required by DEP, Rye Township has a 537 Plan that requires voluntary pumping every four (4) years or before depending on the size of the family. We have relied on residents to voluntarily pump their holding tanks and septic systems. Percentages must increase to 75% or more to justify that Rye Township has informed their residents

and have proof that they are in compliance with pumping regulations. It is imperative that you take the time to pump your system & provide the Township with your pumping receipt. Unfortunately, the **next step** will be the revision of the 537 Plan & the adoption of a Pumping Ordinance establishing **mandatory pumping** for all systems in Rye Township. **Please email, mail or drop off a copy of your pumping receipt. THANK YOU!**

**2011 BUDGET ADOPTED  
NO TAX INCREASE**

The Board of Supervisors of Rye Township adopted an annual budget for the 2011 calendar year on December 20, 2010 during a regular meeting at the municipal building. A summary of the 2011 budget is as follows:

|                      |              |
|----------------------|--------------|
| General Fund.....    | \$577,075.00 |
| Solid Waste.....     | \$188,700.00 |
| Highway Aid Rev..... | \$ 86,000.00 |
| Highway Aid Exp..... | \$120,500.00 |

The 2011 General Fund budget was decreased by 1.9% from the previous year.

The tax to be levied on all real property within the Township for the fiscal year 2011 was reduced to .90 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation due to the reassessment.

Example of an assessment for taxes:

RE Tax .90 mills X \$100,000 = **\$90.00**
