The drop-off event is scheduled for **Friday, September 30** from 6:00 AM to 1:45 PM and **Saturday, Oct. 1** from 8 AM to 12 noon in the rear lot at the Township building. **This service is ONLY provided to residents.** Each residence is permitted to bring one pick up truck-sized load. Four (4) passenger or small truck tires per household are permitted. Hazardous materials are **not** permitted such as: paint products, turpentine, or paint thinners; automotive products such as brake fluid, anti-freeze, oil, gasoline; lawn/garden pesticides, or batteries. All larger refrigerators or freezers must have the Freon and the doors removed. Examples of items that may be dropped off are old furniture, bedding, carpeting, & appliances. Residents are asked to consider donating usable items to local charities.

SEPARATING ITEMS



Please separate larger bulk items such as washers, dryers, water heaters, refrigerators, freezers and place them so they are easily accessible to facilitate unloading of these items into a separate dumpster for scrap metal.

A copy of your last trash bill is required for proof of residency. If that is not available, bring along your current PA driver's license, or other photo I.D. and/or tax bill showing a current address.

NO electronics will be accepted at Clean Up. Please do not bring loads of brush for recycling during the Clean-Up event.



ELECTRONIC RECYCLING

Perry County Conservation District is sponsoring an Electronic Recycling event on **October 1** from **10 AM to 2 PM** at the **Newport Fairgrounds.**

Cost is \$5.00 per vehicle to participate with an additional charge of \$25 for tube TVs and \$10 for Tube Computer Monitors. CASH ONLY accepted for payment. Examples of items that will be accepted for recycling and destruction are keyboards, mice, modems, printers, routers, copiers, cell phones, answering machines, satellite dishes, Plasma/LCD televisions, VCRs, and DVD Players. 





MILLERS GAP ROAD CLOSED CULVERT REPLACEMENT

Millers Gap Road will be closed 8:30 AM, Monday, October 31



through Tuesday, November 22, 2016 until approximately 2 PM to through traffic to replace a culvert & a cross pipe with a 9' X 4' precast concrete box culvert and a 36" HDPE pipe. The existing culvert is inadequate. High water has flooded this area and overtopped the roadway many times through the years eroding and washing out the dirt road and culvert. Wilson Consult-

ing Group, the project's engineering firm, assisted with designing the culvert and acquiring the permit from the PA Department of Environmental Protection, (DEP). Bids for the culvert fabrication and the excavation are scheduled to be awarded at a special meeting on October 6, 2016. With the site located on the dirt section of Millers Gap Road, access to homes for local residents along this roadway will not be affected during this closure.
