NO ELECTRONICS ACCEPTED AT FALL CLEAN UP

NO Electronics will be accepted at the second bulk drop-off event scheduled for **Friday, Oct. 3 from 6:00 AM to 1:45 PM and Saturday, Oct. 4 from 8 AM to 12 Noon** in the rear lot at the Township building. ***This service is ONLY provided to residents.*** Each residence is permitted to bring one pick up truck-sized load. Four (4) passenger or small truck tires per household are permitted. Hazardous materials are **not** permitted such as: paint products, turpentine, or paint thinners; automotive products such as brake fluid, antifreeze, oil, gasoline; lawn/garden pesticides, or batteries. No asbestos shingles, treated lumber, or pool chemicals. All larger refrigerators or freezers must have the Freon and the doors removed. **NO BRUSH** for chipping will be accepted at Clean up. Examples of items that may be dropped off are old furniture, bedding, carpeting, & appliances. Residents are asked to consider donating usable items to local charities.

SEPARATING ITEMS

Please separate larger bulk items such as washers, dryers, water heaters, refrigerators and place them so they are easily accessible to facilitate unloading of these items into a separate dumpster for scrap metal.

A copy of your last trash bill is required for proof of residency. If that is not available, bring along your current PA driver's license, or other photo I.D. and/or tax bill showing a current address.

ELECTRONIC RECYCLING

Since January 2012 State law requires manufacturers of covered devices sold in Pennsylvania to make collection programs available to recycle. Retailers may also offer collection programs.

One of the largest retail recyclers is **BEST BUY**. Best Buy will accept free of charge: TV's, tubed, flat panel- LCD, plasma, LED 60" & less; projectors, portable TVs, desktops, laptops, notebooks, tablets. All in One computers, I pods, MP3 players; phones and chargers, playstation and X boxes. Limit 3 items per household per day. Visit www.BestBuy.com/recycle for more details and info or contact the Mechanicsburg Best Buy on the Carlisle Pike at (717) 795-1741 for their store hours.

Another option for nearby recycling of computers is **Edkin's Recycling** located along Routes 11 & 15 in Marysville in the rear lot of the former West Shore Oil Company property. They will accept computers, peripherals such as the mouse and keyboards, printers and copiers. They do *not* accept TVs or computer monitors. Open 7 days a week. Call for hours at (717) 649-8501.

NEW STYLE TRASH BILLS

Capital Tax Collection Bureau redesigned the residential trash bills. The bills will still be sized 8 1/2" X 11" and include a return envelope; but a bar code will be added to meet new postal regulations. Look for the new style billing to begin with the 4th quarter mailing in early October.

This beautiful, small park located off New Valley Road is owned by the Rye Township Community Association, (RTCA). The Park features trails through wooded wetlands, a stream, playground, pavilion, ball

park and a community building. The RTCA has a 25 year lease with Rye Township whereby the Township provides the funds to maintain the Park & playground. A number of public events are held each year at the Park sponsored by the Rye Township Recreation Board. The last event, "Sundaes in the Park" had over 100 participants in attendance.

The RTCA is a small group of volunteers that manage the Park and is looking to get more residents interested in joining and helping to continue the legacy that began in the late 1950s.
