### PA DEP REQUESTING TANK PUMPING DATA - RYE TWP

**All residents and businesses of Rye Township have some type of on-lot sewage disposal system. Rye Township is responsible for proper operation of all sewage facilities within its borders. Our 537 Plan, adopted in 1996, is under review by PA DEP. The 537 Plan requires voluntary pumping of tanks on an average of once every four (4) years. IT IS IMPERATIVE THAT WE RECEIVE A COPY OF YOUR \*\*RECEIPT FOR PUMPING via mail,**

**email, or drop off to demonstrate to DEP that our residents are in compliance & aware of the need to maintain & pump their systems. It's important to properly maintain your system for the health of your family, your neighbors & your community. In order to provide the statistics requested, we need ALL receipts for pumping for the last four years: 2006 - 2010. We are relying on your help. Thank you to all who have already provided copies of their receipts. ♦**



**The Do 's & Don 'ts of Septic Tank Maintenance**

**The Do 's**

- Pump & inspect your septic tank regularly and \*\*provide the Township with a copy of the receipt.
- Conserve water & fix all plumbing leaks.
- Limit the use of garbage disposals. Consider composting as an alternative.
- Limit the use of harsh, household chemicals that kill the bacteria that enables the breakdown of human waste.

**The Don 'ts**

- Do not plant deep rooted trees on or around the location of the septic tank.
- Do not pour kitchen grease down your drain.
- Do not flush cigarette butts, baby wipes, sanitary napkins, or household trash down the toilet.
- Do not drive heavy machinery over the leach field.
- Do not connect roof drains to the septic system or allow surface water to drain into the leach field.
- Do not ever enter or drain your septic tank.
- Do not ignore signs of problems.

Proper maintenance can prolong the life of your system.
