Spring Clean-up Scheduled May 3rd & May 4th



Even though Penn Waste is contracted to collect the weekly trash, the Township will continue to hold two semi-annual bulk clean-ups. The first event is scheduled rain or shine on **Friday, May 3 from 6:00 AM to 1:45 PM & Saturday, May 4, 2013 from 8:00 AM to 12 noon** in the rear lot at the Township building. ***This service is ONLY provided to residents.*** Each residence is permitted to bring one pick-up truck-sized load. Four (4) passenger or small truck tires per household are permitted. Hazardous materials are **not** permitted such as paint products, turpentine or paint thinners; automotive products such as brake

fluid, antifreeze, oil; gasoline; lawn/garden pesticides. **NO BATTERIES. NO** asbestos shingles, treated lumber, pool or lawn chemicals. All larger refrigerators and freezers must have the Freon and the doors removed.

Permissible items for drop off at clean up: Old furniture, bedding, carpeting, appliances. *Residents are asked to consider donating usable items to local charities.*

SEPARATING ITEMS
In compliance with Act 108 all electronic devices: **TELEVISIONS, computers, monitors, printers, laptops, cell phones, copiers** must be separated from your load for placement in a separate collection trailer.

OTHER BULK ITEM SEPARATION

Please separate larger bulk items such as washers, dryers, water heaters, refrigerators, etc, and place them so they are easily accessible to facilitate unloading of these items to a separate dumpster for scrap metal.

The stub from your last trash bill as proof of residency is required. If that is not available, bring along your current PA driver's license, or other photo I.D. and your tax bill. ♦



Your Local Tax Allocation

A resident's tax dollar amount is based on the millage rate per assessed value of real estate property. Real Estate Taxes are divided among three entities: Rye Township, Susquenita School District, and Perry County. Rye Township's millage remains the same for 2013 at .90 mills. The taxes and millage rate for Susquenita School is 12.20. Perry County millage rate is 3.3125. As you can see Susquenita School District receives the largest percentage at 75% of taxes collected, whereas Rye Township receives only 5% of local taxes paid.

New Electronics Recycling Law

Beginning January 24, 2013, consumers and businesses can no longer dispose of covered devices such as desktop computers, laptops, monitors, keyboards, mouse, printers, speakers, televisions, and e-readers, tablets that browse the internet in their weekly trash.

Best Buy stores provide responsible recycling of all electronics, no matter where they were purchased. They also provide a trade-in program where if there is a value to the item, a Best Buy gift card is issued. Penn Waste Collects Weekly Household Trash on Tuesdays. (See Schedule of Holidays above.) Trash must be at curbside by 6:00 AM. Trash is NOT to be placed out for collection on Sunday evenings. In our rural community, there are too many animals & crows that love to tear open bags & litter is strewn along the roadside. Collection day is scheduled for Tuesday, except as noted above.

- No more than **FOUR (4)** thirty-three (33) gallon bags or **TWO (2)** cans will be collected per week. Weight limit of 40 lbs. for bags; 50 lbs. for cans.
- No bulk items or construction debris will be collected curbside. A bulk item clean up is scheduled in May. (See front page article).

**Prepare for the Worst with
Pennsylvania's New Yellow
Dot Program**

This relatively simple idea could save your life. This effort is part of a nationwide public safety effort that Pennsylvania recently joined. It has proven to be an effective way for drivers injured in an accident to relay important information to emergency response teams.

All you have to do is place a special yellow sticker in the bottom left corner of your vehicle's rear window. This alerts first responders to check the glove compartment for, among other things, your emergency contact information, medical history, and a list of medications. And, best of all, it is "free" to participate.

This initiative is not only valuable to those in serious accidents who are unable to respond to emergency workers. It's also a vital tool in less serious accidents when victims are in shock and may have difficulty remembering things.



Pennsylvanians are encouraged to place yellow dots similar to the one above in their vehicle's rear window. A move that could alert emergency responders and literally save your life.

**2013 BUDGET HOLDS THE
LINE ON TAXES**

The Board of Supervisors of Rye Township approved an annual budget for the 2013 calendar year on December 17, 2012 during a regular meeting at the municipal building without a tax increase:

General Fund\$ 537,850.00
Solid Waste\$ 181,000.00

The real estate tax rate remains at .90 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation and the residential trash rate remains at \$50.00 per quarter.
RE Tax .90 mills X \$100,000= \$90.00
