Spring Clean-up Scheduled May 4th & May 5th

The first of two semi-annual bulk clean-ups is scheduled rain or shine on **Friday, May 4 from 6:00 AM to 2:00 PM & Saturday, May 5, 2007 from 8:00 AM to 12 noon** at the Township building.

This service is only provided to residents. Each residence is permitted to bring one pick-up truck-sized load. Four (4) vehicle tires per household are also permitted.

Hazardous materials are *not* permitted such as paint products, including turpentine or paint thinners; automotive products such as brake fluid, antifreeze, oil; gasoline, asbestos shingles, and pool or lawn chemicals.

Refrigerators *must* have the Freon removed. For your convenience dumpsters will be available on Friday for residents unable to attend on May 5th.



We ask that you separate larger bulk items such as washers, dryers, water heaters, etc, and place them so they are easily accessible to facilitate unloading of these items to a separate dumpster for scrap iron.

Please bring the stub from your last trash bill as proof of residency. ♦

2007 Road/Bridge Projects

Spring has arrived! Road Superintendent Ron Evans & Road Foreman, Brad Sloop, met with District #08 Engineer, Scott Lehman to discuss road resurfacing projects. The following roads are tentatively scheduled for resurfacing this summer:

- Bellview & Ridge Roads
- Elm Street, Brubeck Circle
- Richwine Lane, and
- Idle Road- from the Idle Road bridge culvert north to the SR 850 intersection.

Bids for a large pre-cast bridge culvert & headwalls for Idle Road will be awarded at the March 26, 2007 supervisors' meeting. The start date of the project was established so as not to interfere with

school bus schedules since the last day of school is June 8th.

A tentative schedule follows:

1. Start Date-wk of June 11th
2. Set box culvert- week of June 18th
3. Stoning, grading; road re-opens
4. Road resurfacing in later July 2007,(To allow settling)

It is anticipated that the road will be closed for approximately two weeks to allow for removal of the existing pipes, excavation, setting of the culvert. Variables such as weather may move the schedule ahead slightly. Idle Road residents will be notified with details near the end of May.

Thank you for your understanding as we make this improvement to the culvert on Idle Road. ♦
