Spring Clean-up Scheduled April 30th & May 1st



The first of two semi-annual bulk clean-ups is scheduled rain or shine on **Friday, April 30 from 6:00 AM to 2:00 PM & Saturday, May 1, 2010 from 8:00 AM to 12 noon** at the Township building.

This service is only provided to residents.

Each residence is permitted to bring one pick-up truck-sized load.

Four (4) passenger tire or small truck tires per household are permitted.

Hazardous materials are **not** permitted such as batteries, paint products, including turpentine or paint thinners; automotive products such as brake fluid, anti-freeze, oil; gasoline, asbestos shingles, treated lumber, & pool or lawn chemicals.

Refrigerators/freezers must have the Freon removed. For your convenience dumpsters will be available on Friday for residents unable to at-

tend on May 1st.

We ask that you separate larger bulk items such as washers, dryers, water heaters, cast iron etc., and place them so they are easily accessible to facilitate unloading of these items to a separate dumpster for scrap iron.

Please bring the stub from your last trash bill as proof of residency. ♦

Rye Township Offers Recycling at the Township building—24/7

Rye Township, in cooperation with the County recycling program, was the first Township in the County to place bins at their municipal building so residents are able to recycle at their convenience. The Board is very pleased with the success of the program as tipping fees continue to decrease. The County Commission-

ers announced that as of August 2010, they will no longer fund the recycling program. The Township Board supports recycling & is meeting with the County to discuss options to continue the recycling program in the Township.

The Board has only one reminder: please place the opaque (white) milk con-

tainers in with the detergent bottles and not with the regular milk and ice tea jugs.

The following items may be brought for recycling: tin cans, aluminum, newspapers, cardboard, (including cereal boxes), plastics must be sorted into #1 and #2s. No deli containers or glass. *Thank you all for recycling!! Keep up the great work! ☺*





NO TAX INCREASE IN 2010 BUDGET
The Board of Supervisors of Rye Township adopted an annual budget for the 2010 calendar year on December 14, 2009 during a regular meeting at the municipal building. A summary of the 2010 adopted budget is as follows:

| General Fund..... | \$588,490.00 |
| Solid Waste..... | \$183,000.00 |
| Highway Aid..... | \$ 94,700.00 |

The 2010 General Fund budget was increased by 1.97% from the previous year without a tax increase. Once again not many large projects are proposed for 2010.



The tax to be levied on all real property within the Township for the fiscal year 2010 remains at 1.24 mills on each dollar of assessed valuation.
Example of an assessment for taxes:
RE Tax 1.24 mills X \$100,000 = **\$124.00**
