PUBLIC NOTICE CONTROLLED BURNING

Pine Hill Road Bridge Update

Due to unexpected delays with engineering, State approvals and R-O-W issues the Pine Hill Road Bridge, which was initially scheduled for construction this summer, will now be constructed next spring 2015. The Board anticipates scheduling the construction in mid-June after school is dismissed for the year. The delay of this project until next year may prove to be better for traffic flow. The SR 34 and Sterretts Gap Road roundabout project should be finished before Pine Hill Road is closed to traffic. Construction is anticipated to take approximately three (3) months, depending on the weather.

Road Resurfacing Scheduled

At the May 19th meeting, the Board awarded the paving contract to the lowest bidder, Pennsy Supply, at a cost of \$ 87,577.32 to resurface the entire length plus the 80' cul-de-sac of Mountain Dale Drive and a portion of New Valley Road near the Heisley Road intersection. Total roadway surface to be improved is .93 miles plus the cul-de-sac.

Also, a 73 foot portion of Lambs Gap Road near the last small cabin is scheduled for base repair and resurfacing.

NOTICE: Lambs Gap Road will be closed to through traffic on July 7, 8 and 9, Rain Dates: July 14, 15 & 16, from approximately 7 AM to 1 PM to safely permit this repair. Mowing will also be completed at the same time.
