Report Unauthorized Fire Hydrant Usage

United Water flushes thousands of fire hydrants each year. However, generally this is the time of year when water theft occurs from fire hydrants. Subcontractors working

on construction projects have opened the hydrants without permission to fill a tanker truck, often early in the morning or late in the evening. Unauthorized fire hydrant usage is a violation of the Federal Water System Security Act and is punishable by fine and/or jail term. If you witness someone unauthorized utilizing a public fire hydrant at any hour, dial 911 to report the incident, or call United Water at (717) 564-3662.

Road Improvements Planned

Three residential roads are included in Rye Township's annual 2013 road resurfacing contracts. At a May 14th meeting, the Board awarded the first paving contract to the lowest bidder, Pennsy Supply, Inc. at a cost of \$194,822.40. This contract includes resurfacing the entire length of Dicken Drive, approximately .43 of a mile. A small portion of New Valley Road near Tower Road east to the first bridge will also be resurfaced under the same contract with a total roadway surface to be improved at .68 mile. The average cost of paving per ton for the asphalt is \$73.49.

An additional contract tentatively will be awarded at the July 22, 2013 board meeting for resurfacing of the entire length and cul de sac of Evergreen Drive for .31 of a mile. Roads will be temporarily closed throughout the day of paving and delays can be expected.

Friendly Reminders:

- Pump your septic tank and provide a copy of the receipt to the Township office for the address files in compliance with DEP & the 537 Plan.
- It is unlawful to allow dogs to run at large and for dogs to bark excessively.
- Apply for and obtain a Zoning Permit before starting any construction work. Applications are online at www.ryetwp.com under Zoning. Unsure if a permit is necessary? Contact James Hawk at (717) 756-9492.
- High grass and weeds: Be a good neighbor. Keep your grass mowed and trimmed regularly.
