
**Congratulations!**



## RECYCLING NEWS

Much to the Board's disappointment, **NO GLASS** of any kind or color will be accepted at recycling effective **June 1, 2009**. The County Recycling Program Coordinator explained that there is not a profitable market for glass recycling; therefore, the hauler will no longer accept any glass. The program does accept:

- ★ newspapers                      ★ office paper
- ★ tin,                                      ★ cardboard

*(includes lightweight cardboard such as: cereal boxes, soda boxes, pasta/rice boxes, etc.),*

- ★ Soda/water bottles              ★ milk
- ★ ice tea containers,              ★ detergent bottles, and
- ★ aluminum.

Recycling Drop Off Containers are now available 24 hours a day, 7 days per week for you to stop by and recycle at your convenience. Or, if you need assistance, you can continue to bring your recyclables presorted to the rear of the Township building on the fourth, (4th) Saturday of each month.


### WOOD RECYCLING

A Recycling Grant provided the funds for the Township to purchase a large wood chipper so that residents have a way to dispose of limbs and branches.

Please **DO NOT** bring the following with your wood recycling:

**NO Lumber • NO Briars • NO Vines • NO Stumps • NO Roots**

These items are unsafe for chipping & may also damage the chipper blades. Wood for chipping must not be shorter than 24" in length for the safety of our employees. Contact the office for availability of free wood chips for your gardens & trails.



### Swimming Pools

Residents who are pool owners or plan to purchase a new pool, please be advised that under the Pennsylvania State Act #45,

Uniform Construction Code, all pools with a water depth of 24" (inches) or more require a permit for rough and final electrical and final building inspections. BIU, Building Inspection Underwriters has assembled handouts for the proper installation requirements for swimming pools. The pamphlets are available at the Township office or at BIU in New Bloomfield, 1-877-453-4321. We recommend that prior to a purchase of a new pool, you or your contractor call: Zoning Officer, Ron Cree at (717) 957-3206.

### Homeowners & Home Improvement Contractors — Do you know about Act 132?

Did you know that under the Consumer Protection Act 132, home improvement contractors who do \$5,000.00 or more business per year must be registered with the State Attorney General's office? The law became effective July 1, 2009. The law affords protection for consumers who hire contractors to perform home improvements on their residential properties; the law requires written contracts between the contractor and consumer when the total cash price of all work agreed upon exceeds \$500.00, and the law provides criminal penalties for home improvement fraud and civil penalties for violations of the act.
