

PERMITS REQUIRED

Zoning Permits. Residents are reminded that permits are required for certain interior and exterior work being done on your home or accessory structure. Before beginning any construction, please check with the Township office or contact the Zoning Officer at **602-1493** to check if a permit is or is not required.



Swimming Pools. Residents who plan to purchase a pool, please be advised that under the PA Act # 45, UCC Code, all pools with a water depth of 24" or more require a zoning and a building permit. This includes above ground or in ground pools.

Per Capita/Personal Taxes

Remember: The per capita tax must be paid by all residents 18 years of age and older. These small \$10 tax bills are due by the end of the year. If not paid by year's end, the bills are automatically sent to J P Harris Collection Agency and incur significant penalties. We cannot urge you enough to pay this small bill on time. If your real estate taxes are in escrow, do NOT send your per capita bill to the escrow company. Questions: Contact Becky Schulze, tax collector - (717) 836-5692.

The Do's & Don'ts of Septic Tank Maintenance

The Do's

- Pump & inspect your septic tank regularly; at least every 3-4 years is recommended; AND it is important that you "Provide the Township with a copy of the pumping receipt for your address file."
- Conserve water & fix all plumbing leaks.
- Limit the use of garbage disposals. Consider composting as an alternative.
- Limit use of harsh, household chemicals that kill the bacteria that enables the breakdown of human waste.

The Don'ts

- Do not plant deep rooted trees on or around the location of the septic tank.
- Do not pour kitchen grease down your drain.
- Do not flush cigarette butts, baby wipes, sanitary napkins, or household trash down the toilet.
- Do not drive heavy machinery over the leach field.
- Do not connect roof drains to the septic system or allow surface water to drain into the leach field.
- Do not ever enter or drain your septic tank.
- Do not ignore signs of problems.

Proper maintenance can prolong the life of your system.
