SPRING BULK CLEAN-UP SCHEDULED

The annual bulk clean-up event is scheduled for **Friday, May 5 from 6:00 AM to 1:45 PM and Saturday, May 6 from 8 AM to 12 noon** in the rear lot at the Township building. Held Rain or Shine. **This service is provided ONLY for you as a resident and only for your items.** Each residence is permitted to bring One (1) pick-up truck-sized load. A pick-up load, plus a trailer, will not be permitted and will be turned away. If you are a landlord and are bringing in a load for your rental property, the occupant is not permitted to also participate.

Eligibility requirements for participation. Upon entering the yard area, each resident must provide the attendant a copy of their last quarterly bill from Keystone Collections as proof of residency. If that is not available, bring a current PA photo driver's license and/or a tax bill showing your current address. As this bulk clean-up event is funded by trash fees, residents whose refuse collection accounts are severely delinquent, will not be permitted to participate. Assistance with unloading is provided for the elderly & disabled.

Permitted items. Four (4) passenger or smaller truck tires per refuse account are permitted. Old house and patio furniture, bedding, carpeting, fixtures, appliances, including microwaves, washers, dryers, water heaters, refrigerators, freezers, stoves, and dishwashers. All larger refrigerators or freezers must have the Freon and the doors removed. Please separate larger bulk items such as washers, dryers, water heaters, refrigerators, freezers, dishwashers, stoves and place them so they are easily accessible to facilitate unloading into a separate dumpster for scrap metal.

Non-Permissible items. Hazardous materials are **NOT** permitted such as: paint products, turpentine, paint thinners; automotive products such as brake fluid, antifreeze, oil, gasoline; lawn/garden pesticides, or batteries. **NO ELECTRONICS**, asbestos shingles, propane cylinders, or pool or lawn chemicals.

NO brush for chipping and NO Cardboard Recycling will be accepted the week before, during, or the week following the clean-up event.

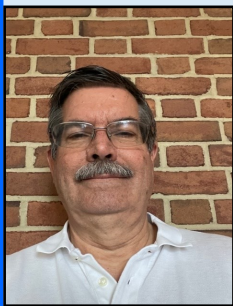

NEW ZONING OFFICER APPOINTED



Rye Township has a new zoning and code enforcement officer. Welcome Max Stoner of Glace Associates of Camp Hill. The Board of Supervisors appointed him to assume the position effective April 3, 2023 with the resignation of former zoning officer, Brian Gilbert on March 31, 2023. Max Stoner, PE offered that he looks forward to getting to know more about Rye Township & its residents. Mr. Stoner began his work in environmental engineering in 1978 & provides a variety of services to public and private clients. We are glad to have him on board at this time of year when permit activity increases.

TAX REBATE FOR ELDERLY

The State Department of Revenue's 2023 Property Tax Rebate program is for property owners whose income limit is \$35,000 a year for homeowners and \$15,000 annually for renters, with half of Social Security income excluded, and who are 65 years old and over, for widows and widowers 50 and over, and for individuals with disabilities who are at least 18 years old. Spouses, personal representatives or estates may also file rebate claims on behalf of claimants who lived at least one day in the claim year and meet all other eligibility criteria. For more information, to obtain forms, or to determine whether you qualify, call the Department at 1-888-222-9190. For assistance in completing the form contact the Perry County Office of Aging at 717-582-5128. Deadline to apply is Friday, **June 30, 2023**. Applicants must provide a receipted copy of their property taxes paid during the calendar year. This program is funded by the Pennsylvania Lottery.

R Major engine repairs plagued the Township this winter. The 2011 dump truck that is used for plowing threw a valve with the cost to replace the engine at over \$17,000. Apparently this engine has manufacturer's defects. Ford has agreed to cover \$10,683.00 of the costs for replacement of the engine. The truck is at L. B. Smiths in Lemoyne awaiting the delivery of the engine. They have several Ford trucks at their garage with the same issue awaiting new engines. We were glad for a mild winter!
