UPDATE ON FIRST TRASH BILLING FROM PAMS



PAMS notified the Township that the first garbage billing from them -- for those that did not pay the entire year already -- will be a **combined bill** representing the **2nd and 3rd quarters** to be mailed **June 28, 2024**. To avoid any late fees or penalties, please remit payment as indicated on the garbage fee bill by the due date. The first billing will only represent the payments due in the current year 2024. There are no rate increases with this billing changeover. Rates remain the same. For those that have paid their garbage bill for the entire year 2024, your first billing from PAMS will be January 2025.

Prior balances, for 2023 and prior, from Rye Township's Garbage Fee Records, if applicable, will be applied to accounts and be reflected on the next bill to be mailed on approximately September 30, 2024. We do apologize for the confusion created with this changeover to PAMS. We appreciate all the calls received, concerns expressed, and your patience. ♦



LOVE AND PROTECT YOUR DOG

Residents are reminded to get their dog, 8 months or older, licensed and a rabies vaccine, for 3 months or older. Buy your PA dog license from your County treasurer, Jan Gibboney, New Bloomfield, 717-582-2131. Township regulations require that dogs must not run at large off their owner's property or defile another person's property. Dealing with pet waste is the greatest source of potential health risk for your pet and family. There are probably fewer things that aggravate neighbors more than a dog that 'goes' in their yard. Please be responsible and clean up after your pet.

HIGH GRASS AND WEEDS

Please help keep our Township healthy and safe by keeping your grass cut to less than eight (8) inches, the maximum allowable height per the Vector Ordinance, and by eliminating weed growth on your property. This does not include agricultural fields. High grass and weeds can pose a health hazard by providing rodents a place to live and can also pose a safety hazard due to their risk of spreading fire, especially in dryer months.

FREE ELECTRONICS RECYCLING



Rye Township receives numerous calls throughout the year about options for disposal of electronics. A new option is Goodwill Keystone Area, who are partnering with Reworld to offer residents across 22 central and southeastern Pennsylvania counties a convenient way to drop-off their old electronic items—including TVs for FREE. This program responds to a critical need in our area, expanding electronic recycling options under the PA Covered Device Recycling Act 108. With 42 stores and donation centers across the 22 counties where Goodwill Keystone Area operates, they are making it easier than ever to recycle a wide variety of electronics. Locations near us are in Lemoyne, Mechanicsburg, Middletown, and Harrisburg. All locations accept electronic recycling.

Listed here are a few acceptable items: Computers, monitors, peripheral devices, video players, stereos, radios, telephones, cameras, TVs, answering machines etc.

Free Notary Service at Township Office

The Township provides notary service for important papers, applications, affidavits, waiver forms, etc. to its residents free of charge. 2024 Road Work



The Township takes pride in keeping its roads in good condition and safe travel. Maintaining the roads is a never-ending task. New Enterprise Stone & Lime Co. was awarded the contract for 2024 at \$151,720. Entire width road resurfacing projects for this summer will include the following: **Stiles Drive** including the cul-de-sac, **Hickory Street** including the cul-de-sac, **Oak Grove Road**, a portion of **Reed Drive** from Woods Drive to Maranatha Drive, and a portion of **Lambs Gap Road**, including several areas of base repair.

These paving projects will take place in July, weather permitting. Expect restrictions on the various roads and a daytime road closure on Lambs Gap Road. The closure will be posted on-site prior to work beginning and on the Township website. As always, be on the lookout for the road and paving crews working and use patience and caution when traveling through all work areas. 

SEPTIC TANK PUMPING

The average household septic system should be inspected and pumped at least every three to four years by a septic service professional. Currently, pumping is voluntary in Rye Township. These are the major factors that influence how often to pump your septic system: Household size, total wastewater generated, volume of solids in wastewater, and septic tank size. Please provide the Township a copy of your pumping receipt for our files.
