TOWNSHIP STILL RECOVERING FROM TROPICAL STORM DEBBY

In the early daylight hours of Friday, August 9, 2024, Tropical Storm Debby moved through Rye Township producing torrential downpours with reports of 6" to 8" of rain falling in a portion of the Township near the eastern boundary leaving debris, flooded roadways, downed trees, and damaged culverts. We thank the Road Crew for their help during and after the storm.


The culvert on Heisley Lane was substantially damaged and the roadway undermined. An emergency permit was approved by PA DEP, temporary repairs were made by the road crew, and the road was reopened restricted to "One Lane" traffic until the culvert replacement is engineered, the permit approved, and the project bid, with completion estimated to be sometime in the new year 2025. Please exercise caution when driving on Heisley Lane.

The picture on the right shows Bryson Hollow Run overtopping New Valley Road near Tower Road. Township engineer, Max Stoner, PE, is in the process of evaluating this culvert also for replacement.

GET AHEAD OF THE WINTER FREEZE

It's not too early to begin preparing for the heating season. Here are a few tips to take care of ahead of time:

- Make sure to have a qualified professional inspect & service your furnace & chimney during the last twelve months.
- Have a covered metal container ready to use to dispose of cooled ashes. Keep the container at least 10 feet from the home or nearby buildings.
- Make sure portable heaters have automatic shut-offs.
- ✓ Plug portable space heaters directly into an outlet.
- ✓ Test your smoke alarms and test your carbon monoxide alarms to make sure they are working. Install one on every level of the home and inside each bedroom.

Make sure children understand to stay at least **3 feet away** from fireplaces, stoves, or space heaters. **Stay Safe!**
