Important Solid Waste Collection Information for Rye Township Residents for 2025

Dear Resident,

Please be advised that Penn Waste Inc will be servicing Rye Township for 1/1/25-12/31/25. We look forward to continuing to service the residents of Rye Township. Our goal is to provide you with superior customer service. Please review the contents of this flyer for useful information on your collection service.

Your weekly collection day is Tuesday. Please have your items placed at the curb prior to 5:00 AM as we will start promptly.

Regular service customers received (1) 96 gallon mobile cart and qualifying seniors received (1) 35 gallon mobile cart. Please continue to utilize the carts for service.

Please limit your waste to the mobile cart provided. Trash placed in mobile carts for collection must also be bagged so as not to expose our workers to raw garbage.

Important Trash Collection Information for RYE TOWNSHIP RESIDENTS

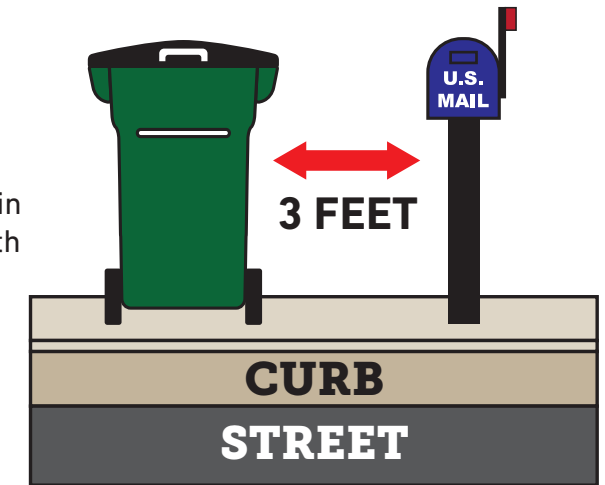
Mobile Cart Information

As part of our contract with Rye Township, Penn Waste has distributed mobile carts to residents for trash service. Contact the Township office for all trash billing changes at 717-957-2348.

Mobile Cart Placement

Please be advised that all mobile carts should be placed behind the curb. There should be nothing placed in the roadway that would impede or delay the removal of snow or ice from the road. The garbage truck arm has the capability to reach past the curb in order to pick up your cans. Here are some tips to ensure a smooth collection process:

- ◆ Set mobile cart out by 5:00 AM the day of collection or the night before.
- ◆ Place mobile cart with the lid handle and wheels pointing toward your residence.
- ◆ Do not place cart in the roadway. Remove cart out of the road R-O-W after collection..
- ◆ Do not block walkways with carts.
- ◆ Place cart at least THREE FEET APART from other obstructions such as mailboxes, fire hydrants, low hanging trees or shrubs, parked cars, or utility poles - so trucks can easily access the cart.



Important Tips for Winter Snow

The Road Crew works hard to ensure the roads stay safe during winter weather. We ask that motorists give our plow drivers a break by following a few tips:

- ◆ Remove all vehicles from roadways and place in driveways, where possible, when snow is in the forecast. Remove all cars parked in cul de sacs. Pull into your driveway and do not park in the cul de sacs. Cul de sacs allow for the larger emergency vehicles such as snow plows to safely turn around. Remove all trash cans from roadways and cul-de-sacs.
- ◆ Allow six car lengths behind an operating snow plow. Give them space to do their job and treat the roadways.
- ◆ Stay alert as slow-moving snow plows can be obscured by blowing snow.
- ◆ Safely move as far away from the centerline when approaching a snow plow head on. Maintaining safe and passable roads is the Township's top priority when dealing with winter weather. To help meet that need, the Township urges residents to not shovel snow onto roads that have already been plowed. Snow should not be shoveled onto any roadway as this can increase the potential for crashes, and property owners can be held liable for any crashes.

Rye Township Recycles Cardboard



Residents may bring flattened corrugated cardboard and shipping boxes to the Rye Township Office's Drop Off Location. The Drop Off, located in the rear lot behind the municipal building, is available to residents from 6 AM to 2 PM Monday through Friday. The Drop Off location will be closed on weekends and holidays. Please only bring flattened corrugated cardboard and shipping boxes to the Drop Off. NO other materials will be accepted, including lightweight cardboard such as cereal boxes. Bulk Item Collection



Residents may now dispose of bulk items curbside by contacting Penn Waste. Residents will be charged a fee, billed directly by Penn Waste, for this service. Once scheduled through our customer service department at 717-767-4456, residents may place the large item at the curb on the date scheduled. Please make sure the item is not too heavy to be lifted by two people.

Unacceptable items include: Automobile parts; Car & truck batteries; Chemicals, stains & liquids; Commercial/Industrial Waste; Construction material such as drywall, masonry, lumber, roofing shingles & tiles; Hazardous waste; Tires on rims; and Electronic waste such as TVs and Computer Monitors.

Observed holidays are noted in **RED**. Collection days that fall on or after the holiday will be delayed one day. EXCEPTION: If holiday falls on a Saturday or Sunday, there is no change in service prior to or after the holiday.

BASIC RESIDENTIAL GUIDELINES

- Trash must be curbside by 5:00 AM on your collection day.
- Bags must not exceed the mobile carts provided to you by Penn Waste.
- Large items such as furniture, freezers, mattresses, broken garden tools, etc. will be collected curbside for a fee, but must be scheduled in advance with Penn Waste.
- Cardboard may be dropped off at Rye Township on New Valley Road from 6 AM to 2 PM and placed in dumpster by resident.
- No electronics: TV, monitors, computers, printers etc. will be collected curbside.
